POSITION SUMMARY

The Worship Production Coordinator ensures the sound, video and livestreaming of Bethesda's worship services are delivered at a high level of quality. Working under the supervision of the Director of Music and Worship, and with the support of other professional staff, the Worship Production Coordinator will further Bethesda's purpose and vision by enhancing the worship experience for all people attending, both in person and online.

DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Maintain and test all audio, video and livestreaming equipment to ensure optimal operation.
- 2. Ensure audio and video is broadcast to other spaces in the building, including the Sanctuary, Commons, Crossroads and Nursery spaces as needed.
- 3. Prepare necessary equipment and operate sound board during worship services.
- 4. Coordinate with streaming team to ensure high quality worship services.
- 5. Train and onboard new volunteers on relevant equipment, as needed.
- 6. Develops and maintains operation and troubleshooting checklist for equipment.

INTERACTIONS

- Reports to the Director of Music and Worship
- Networks with the programming staff to coordinate events and activities.
- Work with Saturday Music Leader to ensure proper sound set up for musical instruments and vocalists.
- Supervises and works alongside volunteers from the congregation.

PROBLEM SOLVING / DECISION MAKING

In addition to proper operation of equipment, the Worship Production Coordinator must diagnose both hardware and software issues with relevant equipment.
